Timeliness of Prenatal Care

The Timeliness of Prenatal Care measure is a Quality Incentive Measure.

Measure Description: Percentage of pregnant women who received a prenatal care visit within the first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment in WOAH.

Measure Specifications

Data: Claims data and Chart Review

Benchmark: 91.7%

Denominator: All live birth deliveries from November 6, 2017 through November 5, 2018 for WOAH members who also meet the continuous enrollment criteria. OHA will identify the live birth deliveries from claims data and provide WOAH with a sample for chart review.

Continuous Enrollment Criteria: 43 days prior to the delivery date through 56 days after the delivery date.

Numerator: A prenatal visit in the first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment in WOAH.

Postpartum Care

The Postpartum Care measure is not incentivized, but is reported publicly as a state performance measure.

Measure Description: Percentage of women with a postpartum care visit on or between 21 and 56 days after delivery.

Benchmark: 69.4%

Denominator: Same as for Prenatal Care, above.

Numerator: A postpartum visit for a pelvic exam or postpartum care on or between 21 and 56 days after delivery.

Continuous enrollment criteria: 43 days prior to the Estimated Date of Delivery (EDD) through 56 days after EDD.
