7.0 The Political Landscape	We invited Carla McKelvey, MD, to our meeting as she is the Vice-Chair of the Oregon Health Policy Board, and has been on the committee for the last 5 years. She participates on the Oregon Health Policy Board because she feels it's important to have a rural voice at the state level. She stated that this is a time of uncertainty at the federal level. Are there things with the Accountable Care Act (ACA) that we can impact? At the state level, our Governor seems committed to keep current coverage and services. Dr. McKelvey explained that almost every state has a waiver. We wanted to use Medicaid funding to help with housing and other social determinants of health, but with the current administration, the thought was that it was more important to get the basic waiver approved, which they did. Dr. McKelvey also shared that there is a Health Equity Committee moving under the Health Policy Board (rural health equity included). Phil Greenhill stated that he appreciated Dr. McKelvey representing the southern coast rural region on the policy board. Phil provided the CAC attendees with the Oregon CCO's (15 of the 16) letter to Chair Greenlick and Members of the House Health Care Committee with comments on House Bill 2122. Phil also provided an update on the efforts to balance the state's budget. Phil indicated that Senator Devlon and the Ways and Means Committee will decide on a budget and share that budget on April 17 or 19, 2017.
