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	state and describes health within 5 categories: social determinates of health, environmental health, prevention and health promotion, access to clinical preventive service and communicable disease. The SHA also provides analysis to highlight health disparities for people of color, people with disabilities, people with low-income, people who identify as LGBTQ, and people who live in rural/frontier areas of the state.
