

Filling prescriptions for members moving to new CCOs

On January 1, 2020, some Oregon Health Plan members in the Portland Metro, Willamette Valley and Southern Oregon areas change to a different pharmacy benefit manager (PBM). This fact sheet explains how to ensure continued prescription access for these members.

Please bill the member's new PBM for continued prescription access

The 2020 PBMs are listed below, including OHA's PBM for fee-for-service ("open card") coverage. The new PBM will honor existing prescriptions approved by the member's 2019 CCO.
