Lualhati Anderson's Day 1: 5th Annual Healthy Aging Conference Confirmation - Gordon, Starla, myself were on the zoom meeting! We have a great older adult behavioral health workgroup lead by Lualhati Anderson. Day two will be great as well!

Connie Hunter stated that Sutter Coast is also providing Monoclonal Antibody treatment.

VA Roseburg's Director over the Office of Community Care, Rocky Phillips (ccd on this Email correspondence) has informed me regarding a provider on the north coast, as follows: "PeaceHealth now has a monoclonal antibody clinic in Florence as well as Eugene. This may be helpful for our coastal patients....." I know that Director Phillips will keep us informed of any other providers as they come to light.

Our Curry County Suicide Awareness & Prevention Council's Veterans Task Group is looking to train vets as THWs - including PSS, CHW and Moral Injury practitioners - we want three teams of one each with PSS, CHW, and MI and a supervisor - called the Power of Ten - & development of Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy.

"Our current program allows for medical staff and other first responders to seek support at their choice of providers and we act as a third party payer, either paying the provider directly for services or covering the costs of co-pays and/or deductibles. We, and SAMHSA, realize that there are instances where an employee may be unwilling or unable to access their employer sponsored "in-network" providers; so we set up our program to bridge that gap. Also, while the service is confidential, SAMHSA does require us to collect Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) data at intake with a follow up about three months later. This data is reported back to SAMHSA anonymously through their secure web portal."
