

Assessments and Screenings for Children Entering Substitute Care

You will be contacted by the Foster Education and Resource (FEARsome) team and Early Intervention to schedule the required assessments and screenings.

- The Coos FEARsome team meets on Thursday mornings at Coos Health & Wellness.
- The Curry FEARsome team meets on the 4th Thursday of the month which is hosted at Wally's House.
- Appointments will be conducted either in person or virtually through computer.
- Early Intervention will be mailing an Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) please complete and return.

Each child entering substitute care must receive the following required assessments and screenings:

- An intake nursing assessment by a DHS contracted nurse, shortly after entering care.
- A comprehensive health assessment by the child's primary healthcare provider within 30 days of entering
- Care.
 A dental assessment for children ages 1 and older, within 30 days of entering care.
- A child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) screening within 60 days of entering care. A CANS screening must be conducted yearly while the child is in substitute care.
- A mental-health assessment for children ages 4 and older, within 60 days of entering care.
- An Early Intervention Screening for children ages 0-2, within 60 days of entering care.
