### **Family Support Services**

Family Support Specialists are individuals with lived experience of raising youth with mental health needs and/or system involvement.

They work as professional advocates for the parents and the family and work with them to express their needs.

### **Youth Support Services**

Youth Support Specialists are advocates with lived experience of being a youth with mental health needs and/or system involvement. They are professionals that work with youth to help them express their needs and thoughts within their systems and the wraparound team.



#### **Referral Process**

Family/Guardian and/or youth want wraparound



The family/guardian or a proxy with consent attend the Wrap Review Committee to discuss what services can help.



If approved, the family will be assigned a Wraparound Care Coordinator to assist with the rest of the process.

If not approved, the family will be referred to other services as appropriate.



The referral is submitted to Advanced Health for final approval.

## **Wraparound**

Wraparound is a collaborative problem solving process that brings together all of the important people and systems in a youth's life to create an individualized plan for addressing your child's needs.

Our team-based model is family driven and youth-guided. It works by building on family strengths, collaborating with community resources and incorporating shared decision-making.

Each approach is individualized and culturally responsive.



## **Eligibility**

Coos County Wraparound Care helps families work through complex challenges related to emotional, behavioral, medical, and/or substance use needs.

A youth may be eligible if they:

- Are under the age of 18
- Are enrolled in the Oregon
   Health Plan, Advanced Health,
   or another qualifying insurance.
- Have a mental health
   assessment within the past year
- Receive services from at least two child serving systems.
- Care coordination needs cannot be met by the other systems.

In Wraparound, the family and youth drive the process and set the goals. Together, the family and their chosen team identify their strengths and use those to come up with individualized plans that fit with their needs.
