state reps and they are hiring someone to oversee		
the dental program. Systems of Care wants to be		
sure that families and members are getting access		
to the care that they deserve. Your concerns are		
noticed and heard, and this is a priority for our		
committee.		
We have a significant wait time across our state		
and across the country. This is not something the		
CCO can have a lot of effects on. OHA is aware of		
this issue, and they are trying to help support		
programs to help with this. We are short of		
providers and nurses.
